



Application for Permit to Park Truck Tractors in Beach Front Parks Belonging to Nassau County

Nassau County Ordinance No. 2016-09 prohibits and regulates parking truck tractors in County-owned Beach Front Parks between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. without a permit issued by the County Manager's Office. County-owned Beach Front Parks include:

- Peters Point Beach Front Park
- Scott Road Parking Area
- Burney Park and associated parking area
- Dunes Club Parking area and walkover (located south of the OMNI Amelia Island Plantation entrance)

Per Ordinance No. 2016-09, Section 2 (Violations), Truck Tractors may be allowed to park in beach front parks pursuant to permit by the County Manager's Office. **Truck Tractors are defined as** a motor vehicle which has four or more wheels and is designed and equipped with a fifth wheel for the primary purpose of drawing a semi-trailer that is attached or coupled hereto by the means of such a fifth wheel and which has no provision for carrying loads independently pursuant to Florida Statutes, Section 320.01(11). **Permits will only be issued for the purpose of special events.**

Permit applications must be submitted to the County Manager's Office at least forty-eight (48) hours in advance to issuance of permit.
